Some wheated bourbons, although
easy to drink, can taste a bit too
sweet without the spicy rye notes
in there. The better ones are often
aged a little longer and/or bottled
at higher strengths, where the
wood and alcohol accompany the
sweetness. You'll find soothingly
rich toffee, caramel fudge, dates,
and nougat brightened up by
berried fruit, and a hint of dusty
corn. Gently sweet finish.



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
