



### Glen Breton Ice



**62.2% ABV**

Aged 10 years in icewine barrels — a Canadian specialty — and like icewine, comes in a tiny bottle. Sweet malt aromas, some grape character, with a brandy-like edge slicing through it. The high proof comes through as evaporative rather than hot, and it's quite drinkable undiluted: some creaminess even, and some of that sweet icewine intensity to it.

A drop of water brings more whisky out: bold, a bit hot. The icewine finishing is an experiment with promise. Price is per 250 ml.



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
