Touches of acetone and magic
marker/solvent suggest that
there's precious little cask
involvement going on here.
Pleasing enough, with lime jelly
and kiwi fruits, and a little whiff of
sweet oak, but it's very
understated. In the mouth, it
performs in a nutty way but
doesn't seem to have moved
much over its quarter of a century
sequestration. There is some
horchata and brazil nut, even a
mashy note, but it either needs
more time or a kick to get it
moving. £70
