It's a brave person who tries to persuade a malt like Lagavulin to go into a different direction. Indeed, even PX casks, from the sweetest fortified wine of all, can't fully obscure the distillery's character, just give it a raisined coating. The creosote turns to tar and licorice, while there's Syrahlike sootiness, and damson. This release is slightly less sweet than in the past and is the better for it, though I still prefer my Lagavulin relatively 'naked.'





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
