

The Macallan Masters of Photography 1989 (Release 3

Cask #12251), 56.6% Dark mahogany with ruby glints and a green rim. Lots of highlypolished oak as we move out of the woods and into a silent country estate. Wax polish and masses of whisky rancio. Sherrysoaked oak, dry leaves, currants, and ripe blackberry. Highly concentrated, but the fruits push their way through only lightly-resisting tannins. There's a hint of smoke and Seville orange bitterness on the finish. My pick of the quartet. Excellent. 285 bottles.
