A whopping three-quarters of the spirit put in these casks was taken by greedy angels. It has a big waft of controllized pineapple, trapical of crystallized pineapple, tropical fruits, and spiky spice on the nose. On the palate, red licorice, syrupy jellied fruits, some mandarin, cherry lozenge, and tinned strawberries, and the same menthol rancio you'd kill for in a 30 year old scotch. This is Amrut's oldest-ever whisky; it's as rare as hen's teeth...and just 8 years old. Awesome.
