Tempest to the world, Dorus Mor in the U.S., this has an intensely salty start that's like being slapped by a wave on Bowmore's harbor wall. That marine note continues: samphire, clams with a squeeze of lemon. Water brings out wet clay.

The palate is equally briny, but with a sprig of lavender, then soft fruits wreathed in peat smoke. It's tense and coiled, with real energy when neat, but it's best like that, so deal with the heat.



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
