

Wemyss Malts Chocolate Honeycomb (distilled at Bunnahabhain) 2001

46% Rich and malty and, though it'll look like I'm just reading the label, there is chocolate here: chocolate brownie mix to be precise, with a raspberry sitting on top. Bold and rich, with a nutty underpinning. Water makes it very fresh and a little more hay-like. The palate is sweet and liquorous, with nought, macadamia, and a chewy midpalate where that chocolate dribbles and melts. Neat, it is slightly bitter; less so with water. Very sound. £53





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
