Distilled in September 1995 and matured for 17 years in a refill hogshead, this bottling of the Aberdeenshire malt Glen Garioch offers a nose of fresh peaches and vanilla, followed by a sprinkling of chili powder, and even a suggestion of boiled ham.

Voluptuous in the mouth, with summer fruits, toffee apples, and a significant amount of ginger. The finish dries quite rapidly, with fruity spices. £60

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
