In this expression you get full integration between oak and distillery, a sparkling mix of seashell and the freshness of seaweed, touched with churned butter, driftwood, and fresh-kilned peat. On the tongue, there's samphire, peat, sweet barley, and an herbal kick. This is Kilchoman coming of age, assured and confident.
