There's something rather round  
peg in a square hole about  
Tormore, that grand urban palace  
of a distillery in wildest Speyside.

The whisky, sadly, is often the  
same. Here, though, things look  
promising to start with: rice  
crackers, and a spicy, rye-like  
hardness on top of a vanilla-  
accented, sweet trail mix of a nose  
with some earthiness behind. The  
palate, for me, is still too rigid. For  
all its efforts to relax, this Tormore  
remains tense. £90



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
