Clearly Caol IIa; it's the way that the oily smokiness seems to lean into the nose, bearing with it wet oilskips a barely smoldering wood oilskins, a barely smoldering wood

Retronasally, there's a touch of green pea pod. The smokiness is more assertive than normal on the tongue, with olive oil, deep fruits, and a pine-scented juniper note. Another belter. (The Whisky
