The initial nose is soft fruits
doused in condensed milk, which
contributes to an overall
impression of light toffee and,
weirdly for this distillery in its
contemporary guise, some smoke.
The fruits manage to mix the ripe
and slightly sour. Quite intense; it
needs water, which calms
proceedings allowing typical Glen
Grant purity to come through. The
fruits now have some added
weight and, again, that smokiness.
