Delicate, with some jasmine, lily of the valley, and even, with time, the rich aldehydes of Chanel No.5.

This heaviness gives a butterscotch-like quality when water's added, alongside apple. The palate is thicker than the light color suggests—it's from a fourth-fill hogshead—with overripe pear and white chocolate; with water, becomes scented with an added touch of marzipan and chestnut puree. One for a thoughtful afternoon's contemplation. £760
