

Ci6 Elements of Islay (distilled at Caol IIa) 61.2% Pale straw. Delicate and a little

akin to chilled *manzanilla* sherry: fresh almond, salinity, light yeast. Vibrant, with the smoke held in check. The palate is much sweeter, with finally some cask-derived sugars beginning to show. Then it rushes to the shoreline and takes a gulp of water, giving an effect like saltwater taffy. It needs water to flesh the palate out. £60/500 ml
