

Bunnahabhain Moine Dram an Stiùireadair 10 year old Feis Ile 2014 bottling

56.6% Stiùireadair means "helmsman" in Gaelic. This has been finished for a year in Marsala casks. The nose is all garden compost, moist vegetation, light smoke, and highly oxidized: like a young *vin* santo (or indeed Marsala). Very nutty, with an almost vermouthlike quality. The palate is all clove, anise, cherry stone. Those oxidized wine notes are so dominant it's shifted the balance toward the finish. This particular helmsman's somewhat off
