Despite the vintage statement, this is 13 year old single pot still matured in first-fill bourbon.

Apparently, it was MIA for eight years before being bottled. Peeled apples, crackerbread, Quaker oats, ripening pears, cappuccino sprinkles, and lightly toasted spices make for a well-composed and inviting prospect. Enveloping and oily with *tarte aux pommes*, fruit polos, allspice, and ground ginger. After a brief effervescent fizz, it expands to become creamier and the spices carry on long after you have swallowed. €350



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
