An unusual, but very fine,
Bruichladdich, with sweet, chewy
toffee notes I often associate with
Speyside whiskies, not Islay
(although I have tasted a few older
Bunnahabhain whiskies that were
like this). Layers of marzipan and
chocolate fudge also emerge, and
I even pick up some apple and
black cherry fruit in the
background. Bruichladdich's "sea
breeze" freshness rises through
the chewy sweetness and provides
balance and complexity.



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
