

High West Valley Tan (Batch #2) 42%

High West has a second version of Valley Tan. The "Utah oat Whiskey" was distilled to 87.5% (about the same proof as single pot still Irish, and technically a "light whiskey"), aged 2 to 4 years in new and used cooperage. A light golden color; nose is light golden color; nose is somewhat spicy, with a licorice/peppermint tinge and some alcohol heat. It's quite smooth, almost Irish in its drinkability, with grainy notes graced with that light peppermint and biscuit sweetness.
