A non-age stated single malt from Washington State. Light amber in color, there's more oak on the nose than you'd expect, along with baked apple, chocolate, cinnamon, and clove. Chocolate leads the entry, followed by clove, cinnamon, baked apple, and salt. A spicy mid-palate picks up some ginger and a dash of heat. The finish is fairly short and dry. This feels a bit young and lacks depth.

An interesting start; let's see where it goes from here.
