Deep amber. Generous sweet
sherried nose; very ripe, with dried
orchard fruits, chestnut puree, and
indeed chestnut honey, then a
little touch of meat and a
pungency akin to Guyanan pot still
rum. Sumptuous. As it opens
there's a fluxing mix of sticky
toffee, game, pomegranate, and
dried red fruits. The palate is
deeply savory, with floor polish
and cooked plums, finishing with
fragrant pepper. The cask has a
huge say in things, but the spirit
copes. Excellent. £191



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
