Pale straw. The nose is very draff-  
like/sweet mash, then green  
herbal notes, reminiscent of  
angelica. The palate remains light  
and slightly hot on the tongue,  
with some cereal and a certain  
fatness. Water brings out a little  
more from the cask. A delicate and  
pleasant enough dram, but I'm  
slightly bemused as to why it's  
being bottled at this age when  
there's clearly so much more to  
give. £69



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
