



Two James Johnny Smoking Gun (batch 3)

“Smoked” with a maceration of Lapsang Souchong tea (which leaves some fine sediment).

Thickly sweet and herbal nose in a ruddy whiskey; like a sweetened, aged genever. On the palate, this 70% 7 year old MGP corn, 30% unaged Two James rye is woody and ash-bitter in the core, with a wrapping of that sweetness. The herbal character saves it from the squabble between sweet and bitter, but it comes off more as a tonic than a whiskey.



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
