phenolic, reminiscent of standing
downwind of a peat kiln.

Interwoven spice (especially
pepper), seaweed, and sweet &
sour notes add complexity. Light
to medium in body, but quite oily.

Nicely balanced flavors of peat
smoke, seaweed, salt & pepper, all
wrapped up in a gentle sweetness.
Lingering peat smoke and spice on
the finish. Yet another example of

Caol Ila's fine pedigree. This
bottling has great balance, and I
especially enjoy how the smoke
and sweetness marry together. My
only criticism is that it is a bit soft
for Caol Ila. I would love to try this
whisky at 46 or 50% ABV, which
would give it a bit more guts.



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
