The nose on this whiskey is like smelling a wet empty barrel; it's all oak, char, and cinnamon spice.

The entry is thin, watery, and understated with light caramel and cinnamon. In the mid-palate, the oak tannins completely take over.

It's not just oak spice, but the puckeringly dry, sour, and bitter tannins. This all leads to a bitter, bone dry finish. Good whiskey is a conversation between spirit and wood, but here the wood is doing all the talking.
