Fruits are to the fore here, super  
ripe, and dark in hue: think of  
plump plums, sweet black grapes,  
and hedgerow berries. That said, it  
is never heavy, as if it's just the  
aromatics of the fruits which have  
been preserved. In time, some  
dried flowers emerge. The palate  
is equally sweet, with a little  
caramel and spice. It fades gently.  
Impressive and well worth a look. I  
wonder whether the new  
Dalmunach distillery will produce  
anything like this? £213



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
