This is the Lowland entry into Douglas Laing's Remarkable Regional Malts collection, and on approach the nose is like sipping lemonade in a malt hopper: gristy malt, lemon, lime, honeydew melon, vanilla pods, peach, and apricot. A similarly juicy palate, gaining sweet grassy notes, Spangles, and confectioners' sugar, before ending on a finish of dried citrus and fizzy Refreshers.

True to the region, but the Epicurean makes the rest of the range look brighter, quicker, smarter, and tastier in comparison. £34



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
