


Barr an Uisce 1803 10 year old 46%



To stand out in the increasingly crowded marketplace of sourced, single malt Irish whiskey, you need a good, original hook: this whisky is cut with Wicklow water. Shhh! Don't tell St. Kevin. The bourbon casks have developed a sweet, honeyed nose with fresh hay, peach pit, and some mature oak characteristics. Lighter weight than the blend (*see below*), it relinquishes golden honey, satsuma, ground ginger, crystal sugar, and tame spices. Pleasantly





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
