Like a trip to the stalls of an old
spice market, the traders
beckoning you closer with their
colorful wares. Nutmeg, fennel
seed, and caraway on the nose,
then papery dried oak leaves,
toast crumbs, and slightly pungent
notes of chive and shucked pea
pods. This is a fatter, more
glutinous whisky than the single
malt. Lemon glaze, fudge, honey,
nectarine, and kumquat balance
an undercurrent of pepper,
cinnamon, and mustard seed. A
slightly sour swallow, then the
spices reign supreme.



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
