A fiesta of apple, pineapple, grapefruit, bitter lemon, subdued honey, and caramel transition into stewed apples, rhubarb, lemon bonbons, and sweet vanilla. Lingering bitterness, like the band's split. It's a Big Apple Fairytale, but for the money, better streams of whiskey are available.



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
