rose potpourri, peach blossom,
lemon drops, strawberry
shortcake, talcum powder, and
clean cereal notes on the nose.
Candied rose petal on the palate,
as well as dried fruit (especially
with water), rich and well-
integrated spice, cacao nibs, and
dry oak. It's distinctive and well-
balanced, even when the oak
seems a touch bitter. The finish is
dry and leathery, with pipe
tobacco, cinnamon, and, still, that
