Distinct aromas of gooseberry on the nose, supported by barley freshness, light vanilla, sour cherry, and faint nutmeg notes. The taste is akin to walking through an orange grove. Lightbodied, smooth, and oily in structure with sweet citrus flavors, tangy strips of peel, fruit Jell-O, honey, subtle oak, and light spices before the gooseberry acidity returns adding further complexity, with spiced orange and cedarwood on the lengthy finish.
