empty bourbon barrels baking in
the sun. On the palate, sweet
concoctions of lemon curd,
oranges, and chalky rock candy
are bridged by peppery smoke to
an oilier phase of nougat, almond,
and seasoned oak, ending with
creamy chocolate notes. Talisker
has released older bottlings, but
these are the last of the casks
from 1984. (968 bottles)
