Good balance between ripe barley, rum-like sweetness, and damp kiln smoke. Dried oak spice, bourbon char, brine, and anise add complexity, peaking on the finish.

An interesting contrast to the other Amrut whiskies. This whisky could pass for a youthful Islay malt.
