old. Nicely balanced — Lorne
Mackillop's hallmark — and
somewhat reserved, too (for a
Mortlach), with intriguing lime, kiwi, caramel, floral notes (on the nose), nutty toffee (especially on the palate), soaked barley, and charcoal, with a rather syrupy, mouth-clinging texture toward the finish. Worth a look.
