Great to see Ledaig hitting its
stride, with a brisk punch of peat
and not chill-filtered. There's a bit
of a raw edge too, quite bracing
but still plenty of soothing
sweetness. Earthy peat smoke,
ripe barley, honeyed vanilla,
bourbon barrel char, black licorice
stick, espresso bean, olive brine,
and suggestions of beef jerky. In
some respects, it even tastes
younger than 10 years old, but I'm
balancing that with bonus points
for distinctiveness.
